

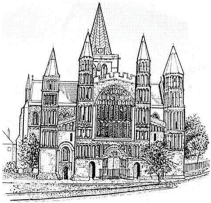

Cathedral News— Following the successful completion of **Ancient Stones, Untold Stories**, our 3 year / £1m, HLF programme, we were very pleased to hear that

we have been awarded the first stage of a £3.2m grant from HLF for our new programme **Hidden Treasures, Fresh expressions**. A major part of the project will give full access to the crypt, quire and library for mobility impaired visitors as well as allowing visitors to experience many major treasures and important historic documents which are currently stored away. The education department will be creating new programmes, resources, handling boxes and outreach projects as part of the development.

Christmas / Epiphany Programme—



Although Christmas still seems a long way off it will be here before we know it! We have a range of Christmas / Epiphany related offers this year. On 21st, 25th and 28th November we have our Foundation / KS 1 Christmas Activity Days in the cathedral, 10.15—14.30, 4 workshops and nativity tableau (£4.50 per pupil. Max. 4 classes per day). For those schools within a 30 minute drive of the cathedral we offer F / KS1 Christmas outreach, two workshops chosen from drama, dance or music plus a final nativity tableau (2 hour session for up to 60 pupils/ 2 classes, £150 per session). Finally, come for an hour in January, do our nativity / Epiphany treasure hunt and visit the crib (£2 per pupil). Add another Christmas workshop or regular programme workshop for an additional £1.40 per pupil.

To celebrate the 400th anniversary of the King James Version of the Bible this year Rochester Cathedral, in partnership with renowned artist / calligrapher Nick Stewart, is mounting an innovative art exhibition. Using phrases from the King James Bible, Nick, 9 A-level art students from Medway / Kent and a cathedral volunteer, have created a stunning display using just ink, bleach and water. The exhibition runs from Saturday October 22nd to Friday 4th November in Rochester Cathedral crypt, 10.00—16.00 most days (closed during services). As well as our normal Tuesday family drop-in session we will have an activity related to the exhibition running in the crypt each weekday during the autumn school break.

Special Schools Update

As part of the cathedral celebrations for the bi-centenary of Dickens' birth in 2012 we are running "Dickens" themed drama workshops for special needs schools on Wednesdays during May. SEN specialist and author Keith Park will run these half-day noisy, boisterous, exciting and entertaining workshops giving pupils a new insight into Dickens and his works. Funding has already been secured for these workshops and SEN schools are invited to contact us on a first-come, first-served basis.
