Plates 8&9: Details of the upper area of the spandrel, before (above left) and after (above right) treatment. Plaster fillet repairs were applied to delaminating edges and a grout injected into voids in the area to the right of the vertical crack. The large piece of white, later inappropriate repair plaster was removed, to reveal the original painted surface.
