CHRISTMAS SERVICES AT ROCHESTER CATHEDRAL

Tier 4 – COVID secure guidance for those attending Christmas services in the Cathedral

- Entry to Midnight Mass and Christmas Day Eucharist is by ticket only. We are very sorry but if you do not have a ticket then you will not be able to attend these services
- As per current Government guidelines, **face coverings must be worn at all times** unless carrying proof of exemption
- **Sanitiser must be used on entry and exit** to the building as well as at the sanitiser points throughout the Cathedral when moving around
- The chairs have been placed either singly or in pairs, within the social distancing guidelines and therefore cannot be moved, **please remain in your seats at all times**
- There are no public toilets currently available in the Cathedral
- There will not be a collection during the service, if you wish to donate please use one of the collection boxes or contactless giving points situated near the doors
- During Communion, please follow the directions of the stewards at all times and do not leave your seat until you are invited to do so. Please ensure that whilst moving around the Cathedral that you **maintain social distancing at ALL times**
- When leaving please do not socialise with anyone. You will be able to leave via the nearest exit, the Great West, the small West doors and North door. If level access is required, then please use the North door
